Course Bachelor of adult learning and development.

While there are many skilled people training others as part of the multifaceted world of adult education, those without a university qualification may find getting formal qualifications in the "how" of what they do to be useful.

"There is strong demand from professionals engaged in teaching and learning in the adult, VET and private training sector to develop their skills and knowledge in adult education. This course offers professionals in industry an opportunity to gain formal-degree-level qualifications in adult learning and development," says a course co-ordinator at Monash University, Damon Anderson.

The course is aimed at adult educators in TAFE and registered training organisations, as well as community-education providers, training consultants and those working as workplace mentors.

Duration Three-year course. Can be completed in two years (full time) with recognition of prior learning.

Time A mix of on-campus seminars and online learning.
