Teach English, see the world

Course TESOL (teaching English to speakers of other languages).

With an estimated 1 billion people learning to speak English throughout the world, there is considerable demand for native English teachers.

“Places such as China can’t get enough teachers, and then big economies in Asia – Japan, Hong Kong and Thailand – are looking for teachers on an ongoing basis,” the chief executive of Teach International, Adam Morehouse, says.

The certificate IV in TESOL is a required qualification for teaching English as a second language in Australia. The certification also meets most requirements overseas.

“Many people do it to try something different. They see teaching English overseas as a way to stay and see a country as a local,” Morehouse says.

Cost \$2495, including textbooks.

Payment plans are available.

Duration About four months (part time) for the three course components: online component, five-day intensive and six hours of practice teaching.

Time Five-day intensive runs Wednesday to Friday evenings, plus all Saturday and Sunday.

Where Capital cities in Australia, as well as Istanbul, Hanoi and Kyoto.

When Start any time (online component is first).
